the audience tomorrow. I think it highly

Princeps this evening, as I shall be that I
proposed to make my report to the King
on Wednesday. If your Royal Highness
will signify the hour at which you are
to have me wait upon you tomorrow morning
I will pay my duty punctually at
that time.
