Lord North has the honour of
sending his Majesty the Letters he
mentioned this morning which he
takes the liberty of accompanying with
a note of the manner & date of the
Dissolution & meeting of Parliament in
1774. by which his Majesty will
see that the Dissolution may be on
the first of September, & the meeting
on the 31st of October. Mr Robinson

seems inclined to the first of September
-her, as it will give him two or three
days for notices round the kingdom.

Lord North has the honour of

to which he will give immediate
attention & obedience.
