My Dear Mr Mahon

I have not seen your Friend -
Capt Wilson of the 83. I was not at home
when he called - and come up here for I
am not in Kingston but at a small house
I have bought to be more cool, and pleasant
than in town immediately afterwards - It
is how. quite sufficient that you and my
Friend Carter interest yourselves for him
for me to take him by the hand, and
do all that lays in my Power for him.

In consequence of which I will inform you
that I am without a Major of Brigade, that
H. R. H. the D. of G promised when I left
England to provide me one - but I believe
forgot - I refreshed his Memory some time

since - should he ~~not~~ yet have appointed
one - I shall be very glad if he will name
him - I wish you joy of the great and
rapid successes of the Allies. I cannot
help regretting very much to have no share
in them believe me my Dear Friend
