I arrived here last night
but, my letters having been stopped in Cork,
I know nothing of what is going forward.

I will thank you much for any information.

My present disposition is to be in London
on Tuesday evening, so as to attend the
Levee next day. Then I shall take the
opportunity of stating in the House the
present position of affairs in Ireland,

the result which has brought matters to their
condition. After having so discharged my con-
-science, I shall return hither & have no
-thing further to do with Parliament or
Politics.
