Agreeable to Ad. North's desire I have sent the letters from America to the Treasury, but chose just to write to him a few lines to express my Approbation of the Minute of Cabinet and that I have in consequence ordered the 3^d, 19th and 30th Regiments from Ireland to the Leeward Islands. The 1st Bat. of the Royals. 13th and the 69th to Charles Town; orders are given for the transports to be prepared and the officers of the 2^d, 5th and 49th Regiments to be put on the Irish Establishment, in lieu of the three Regiments taken from thence.

The Regulations Ad. North has sent down to the Comptroller will I trust be of effect; but I must have a good deal of conversation with Ad. Sandwich that the Frigates may be more employed both to protect our convoys and annoy those of the Enemy.
