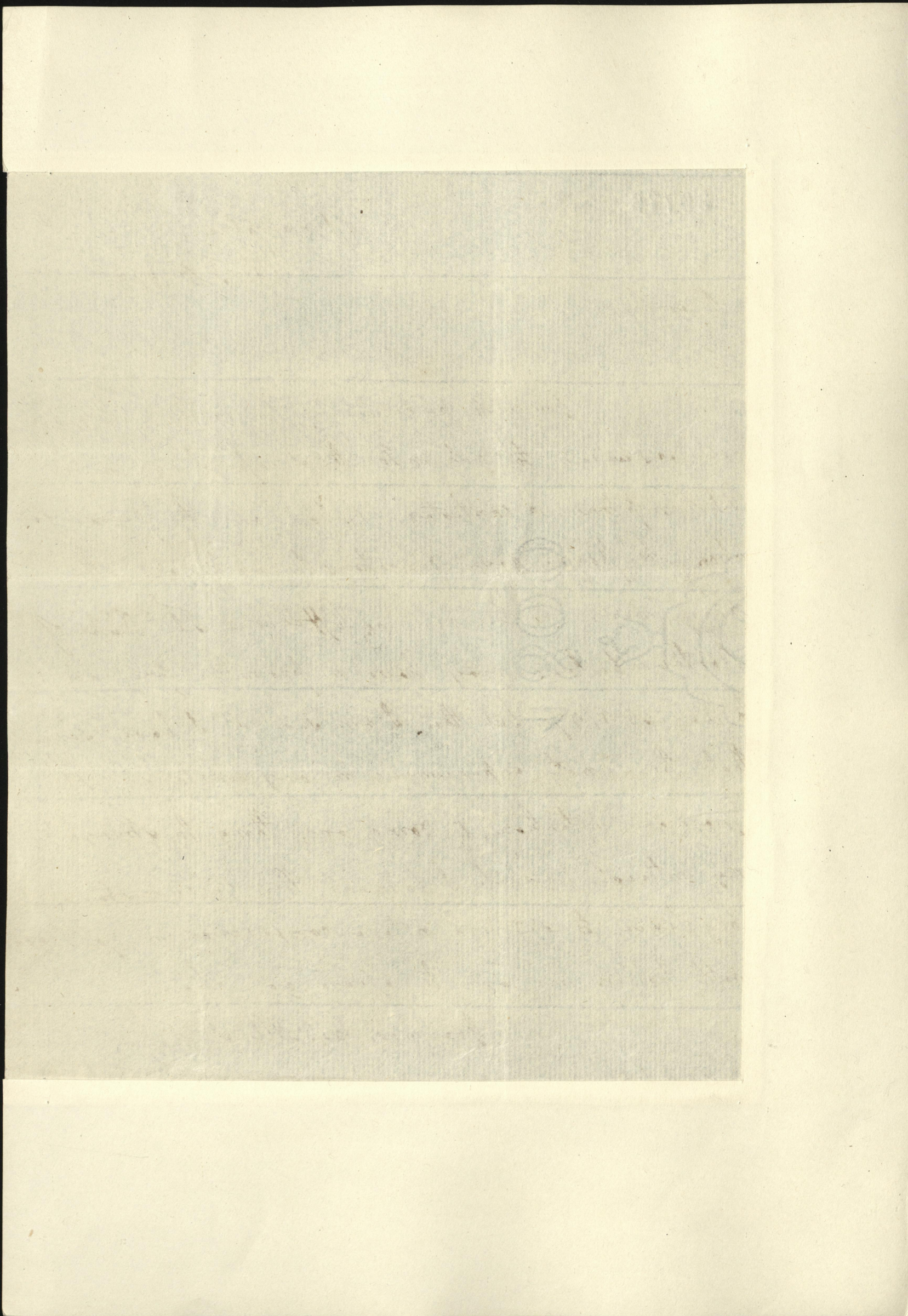
Dear Sir

Fully convinced Mr Holland that the estate at

permission to let my name remain as the buyer, and
if any difficulty should arise with any of the tenants
or others, my servants shall have my commands to
have them removed, in short I shall be glad to do
any thing that can strengthen your interest.
