His Majesty will see his Lordship's opinion about
a regiment of Dragoons, & the reason of his
feeling his regiment particularly injured by
being now sent to Ireland.

Lord North begs leave to return his Ma-
-jesty his most humble & most grateful
acknowledgements for his gracious enqui-
-ries after his health. He hopes that
he is quite recover'd from his fever by
the use of the Bark, & that he will require
nothing but the repose of a day or two

to regain his strength.
