" We attest that the answers to the questions submitted  
" to us by His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales are correct,  
" as stated on the preceding page X. And have only to  
" add to the answers given by the 3<sup>d</sup> question "

" That to the best of our recollection, we answered  
" that the Countess was no other than such as might arise  
" in His Majesty from the knowledge of the servants being  
" at hand, but that Doctor Simmons had assured the  
" Physicians that there had been no occasion for their  
" interference for some time past. "
