My Dear MacMahon,

I have infinite satisfaction
in acquainting you, that in communi-
cating to the Duke of York the subject
of our conversation of Sunday last, His
Royal Highness rejoiced himself most
anxious for the full and cordial recon-
ciliation taking place between the Prince
of Wales and himself, so greatly to be
desired - He readily entered into the idea
of removing the Prince's Regt. to the Eastern
part of the Coast of Surinam, as a measure
likely to be pleasing to His Royal Highness,
and will submit the arrangement to
His Majesty forthwith - Believe me
