Lord North has the honour of requesting
his Majesty's pleasure, whether he would
charge that Lord Carlisle should kiss
his Majesty's hand on Friday next. Lord
Shelbrough has written to the Lord
Lieutenant, but has not, & indeed, Lord
North believes could not as yet, ^{have} received
his Excellency's answer. It is not ap-
-pear to Lord North, that it will be
necessary to receive the Lord Lieutenant

answer before Lord Corbick takes his
Majesty's hand, but Lord North thought
it right to mention this circumstance
to his Majesty, that a further day may
be appointed for Lord Corbick, if it should
appear proper to his Majesty to send
the Lord Lieutenant's answer.
