~~humbly~~ to advise His Majesty to dissolve
Parliament towards the end of this
month. The measure has not yet been
communicated to our friends, and the

the negotiation on one hand, and the
necessity of an early meeting of the new
Parliament on the other, have unavoidably
prejudged this resolution forward.
