I have returned to express your Majesty's satisfaction in the very friendly answer given by the Emperor, and have declared saying any thing positive respecting the Place of Sorcery, till the Emperor has his own that subject could be known, stating this as a proper attention to the Emperor and the necessity of our being equally attentive to both Medications
