As Master of the Incorporated Society of
Merchant Adventurers of the City of Bristol, I
shall feel myself particularly obliged if you
will inform me where I may in company
with the Wardens have the honor of waiting on
his Royal Highness, ^{the Prince of Wales} to present him with the
Freedom of the Society which was this day
unanimously voted

The attendance of the Master being by their
Charter absolutely necessary to constitute a
Hall, I very much regret that owing
to my absence the Society were prevented

from showing this mark of their respect
to his Royal Highness at the time he
honoured the City of Bristol with his
presence.
