to the present Constitution so numerous on the Division in  
the House of Commons last Night.

The Corps of the late Bishop of Winchester was carried  
from Chelsea Yesterday. I therefore think the Bishop  
of Worcester & whom I met on the Road Yesterday and the  
Bishop of Litchfield should receive notice from you  
that they may come this day to St. James, when I  
shall direct the Secretary of State to prepare the  
large d'Chire for the Chapter of Winchester.
