Lord Buckingham humbly presumes to inform
his Majesty that the Draft of the proposed
message & address could not be prepared to be
laid before his Majesty so expeditiously as
Lord Buckingham hoped. It is not quite
perfected & has not yet been communicated
to many of his Majesty's servants for their opinion.
Lord Buckingham imagines the marginal corrections
will be proper & hopes to have the Honour of
explaining to his Majesty tomorrow the Reasons
for which it was thought expedient to name
particularly his Majesty's Royal Brothers.
