a Memorial from Lord Rawdon being read

to His Majesty that considering the
eminent Services of the Irish Regiment
raised by Lord Rawdon in America, and
the peculiar circumstances which
distinguish it, It would be expedient
that the above Regiment so soon as
completed from Ireland in the manner
proposed should be put upon the
British Establishment, Lord Ambert
sees no objection to the shewing every
distinction to Lord Rawdon but has strong
military objections to this arrangement.
