Lord George likewise takes the liberty of
recommending to your Majesty George Schuchter
Subaltern the son of Major James Schuchterland
to be Clerk of the Markets in Jamaica in the
room of Anthony Wheelock deceased, his Office
has been vacant for some months and is
valued at one hundred and fifty pounds
a year. Lord George was in hopes of paying
his duty to your Majesty at St James; but being
informed there was no leave he hopes your
Majesty will excuse him making his application
in West Market.
