Mr Partington in whose name the
Purchase of the Manor of Kingfield has
been made. He wishes to know to whom
his Majesty would have the Purchase
assigned; It was ^{made} in Mr Partington's name,
as it was expected that the terms would

be more reasonable than if it had been
made in the name of any person who
would be consider'd as a Trustee of his
Majesty.

made out & will be deliver'd to him as
soon as his Majesty shall think proper
to order it.
