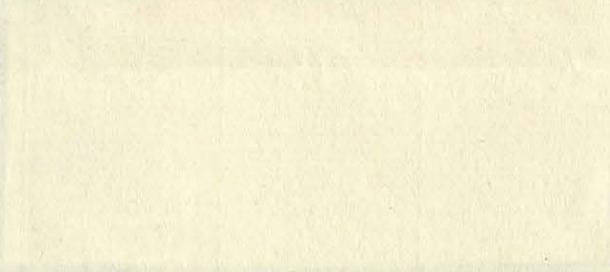

Minute of Cabinet  
14 August 1782.

It is humbly recommended to your Majesty in Addition to  
that which was to be offered for your Majesty Approbation this morning  
that Lord Supper be Impowred to advise with Lord Howe at Portsmouth  
how probable it may be for the measure that directs his Lordships going  
into the North Sea being performed in time, so as to enable the fleet  
to again join force at Spithead, In order to proceed at latest in the  
first week in September, with the necessaries and Supplies for the relief  
of the Garrison of Gibraltar, and that Lord Howe's proceeding to the Northward  
should depend upon the probable Certainty of his getting back to Spithead  
by the time mentioned.
