Lord Shelburne there is no kind of probability that my Youngest son  
can survive the day, I cannot think therefore of leaving the Queen  
tomorrow but trust that Religion which is the only solid assistance  
to those who are in affliction, will so far compose her mind  
that I may on Friday as usual be at St. James's. I desire you  
will acquaint the other Ministers of this and that any business  
that requires being communicated to her may be sent, for I  
should be sorry that at so critical a time any business should  
be in the least suspended.
