Chancellor's Communication from His Majesty
respecting the Education of the Princess Charlotte.

The Lord Chancellor will be pleased to state
to the King that the Prince laments the absence
of Lord Moira at the present moment as it renders
a delay in returning an answer unavoidable.

The leading part Lord Moira has had in the discussions
which have taken place, makes the Prince feel it
to be due to his Lordship that he should be consulted
in every step respecting the delicate subject in
which he is engaged. From the Lord Chancellor's
letter to the Prince he presumes he shall soon
see Lord Moira in town when he will lose no
time in returning an answer.
