The King authorises The Lord Chancellor to inform The Prince of Wales that he has received with Satisfaction the Answer to the Paper; which The Lord Chancellor sent to the Prince of Wales from His Majesty: and will, in consequence, proceed, with as little Delay, as the due Consideration of so serious a Concern requires, to state to the Prince through the same Channel, for The Princes Consideration, the Names of the Persons, that shall occur to His Majesty, as most likely to suit the Instructions, necessary for the Care & Instruction of his Grand Daughter: who has every Gift from Nature to render her capable of profiting by that Care and Attention, which may render her in future an Honour to her Family, and a Blessing to those, if it pleases the Almighty to preserve her life, who must in a future Day acknowledge her as their Sovereign.
