The Prince of Wales desires to acknowledge the receipt of the Paper which the Lord Chancellor transmitted yesterday from His Majesty.

Truly sensible how much His Majesty wishes that the Arrangement should give the completest satisfaction to all Parties, the Prince would think that he did not do Justice to the King's gracious disposition were he not to suggest any alteration which occurred to him as desirable on so important a Subject.

In this sentiment, the Prince ventures to express his earnest hope that the King may design to reconsider an Article of this Plan, upon Grounds relative to which the Earl of Spina is authorised to confer with the Lord Chancellor.
