The King has learnt with very serious concern from the letter which he received yesterday from Mrs Campbell that the State of his Health is such as to render him incapable of discharging any longer to his own Satisfaction the Duties of the Situation of Sub Governor to the Princess Charlotte of Wales, in which his Majesty was induced to place her from a thorough Conviction of her Merit and estimable Qualifications. The King cannot acquiesce in Mrs Campbell's Request to be permitted to retire from it, without assuring her, that her Conduct has not disappointed him in the favourable Opinion with which he was impressed, and which, whilst it causes his Majesty to regret her loss, will secure to her his best Wishes for the Restoration of her Health and her future Welfare.
