Sir

I have this day rec^d Lord Dartmouth
who informs me that in consequence of
what had passed between His Majesty and
him last year he had named a Person of
the name of Withis, who is in the Lord Steward's
Office, to be Auditor & Comptroller of accounts
of the Establishment of Her Royal Highness
the Princess Charlotte.

to take any final step in the business till
I knew whether Your Royal Highness approved
of this appointment, and I have therefore
taken the liberty to trouble Your Royal Highness
with this letter. If there should be an objection
to it I will immediately insert Mr. Willis's name

the Establishment according to the footing
proposed last year with the addition of
£1000. p. ann. to cover unforeseen expences.
