that Lord Grantham should answer
the French Paper delivered by M^r
Vergennes to M^r T^r Herbert on the 6th
of Oct, and should state your Major-
ty's Intentions on each of the Articles
of the Specific Propositions contained
in the French Memorial.

The Conditions of Peace proposed by
Spain, in a Memorial of the same
date, delivered by M. D'Aranda to
Mr T^r Herbert, are such, that it is humbly

they are answered, Mr T^r Herbert should
be instructed, to discover, whether they
are meant by that Court to be ulti-
mate Propositions
