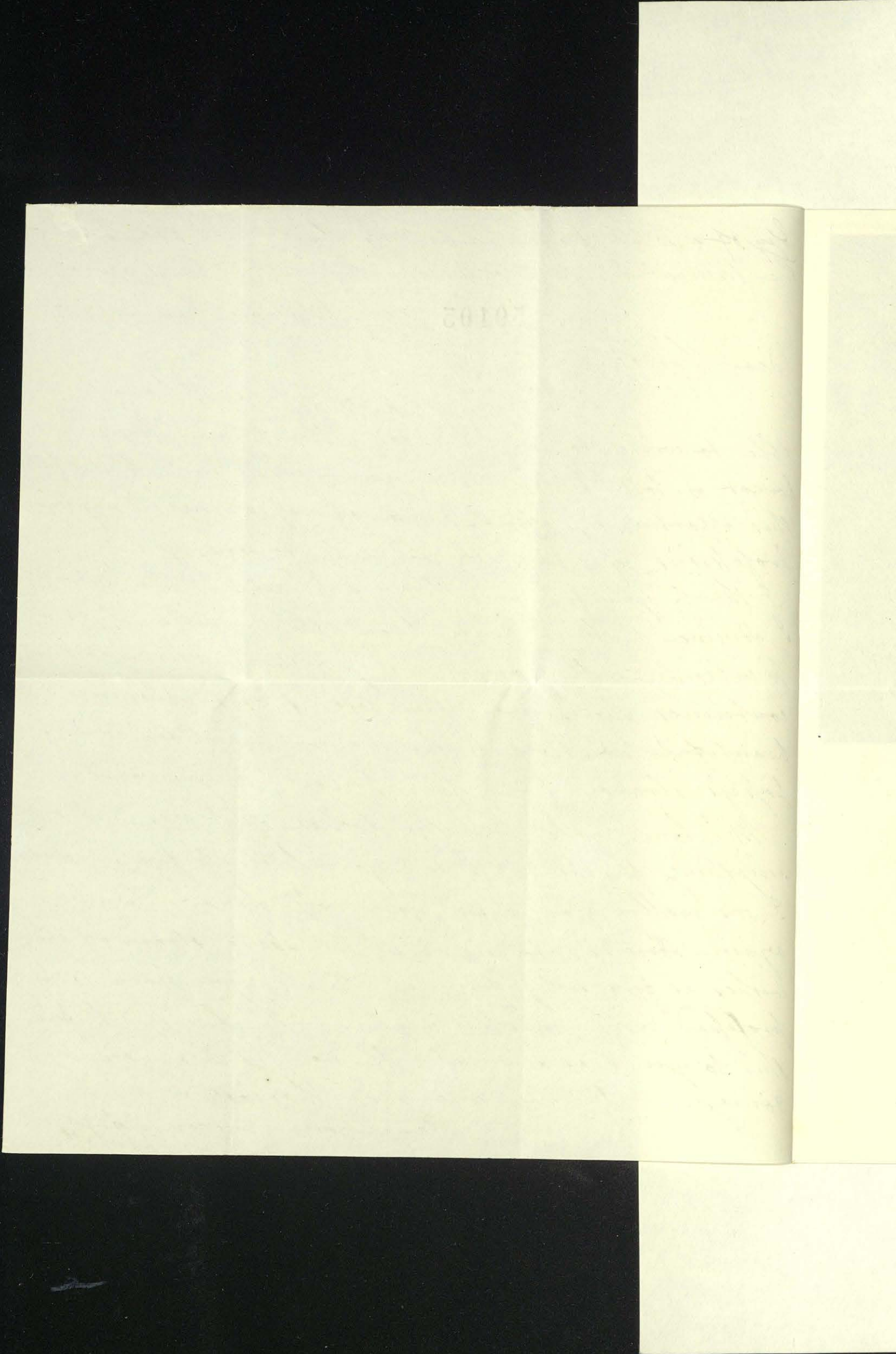
Dear Charlotte

professions of interest & good will towards you -

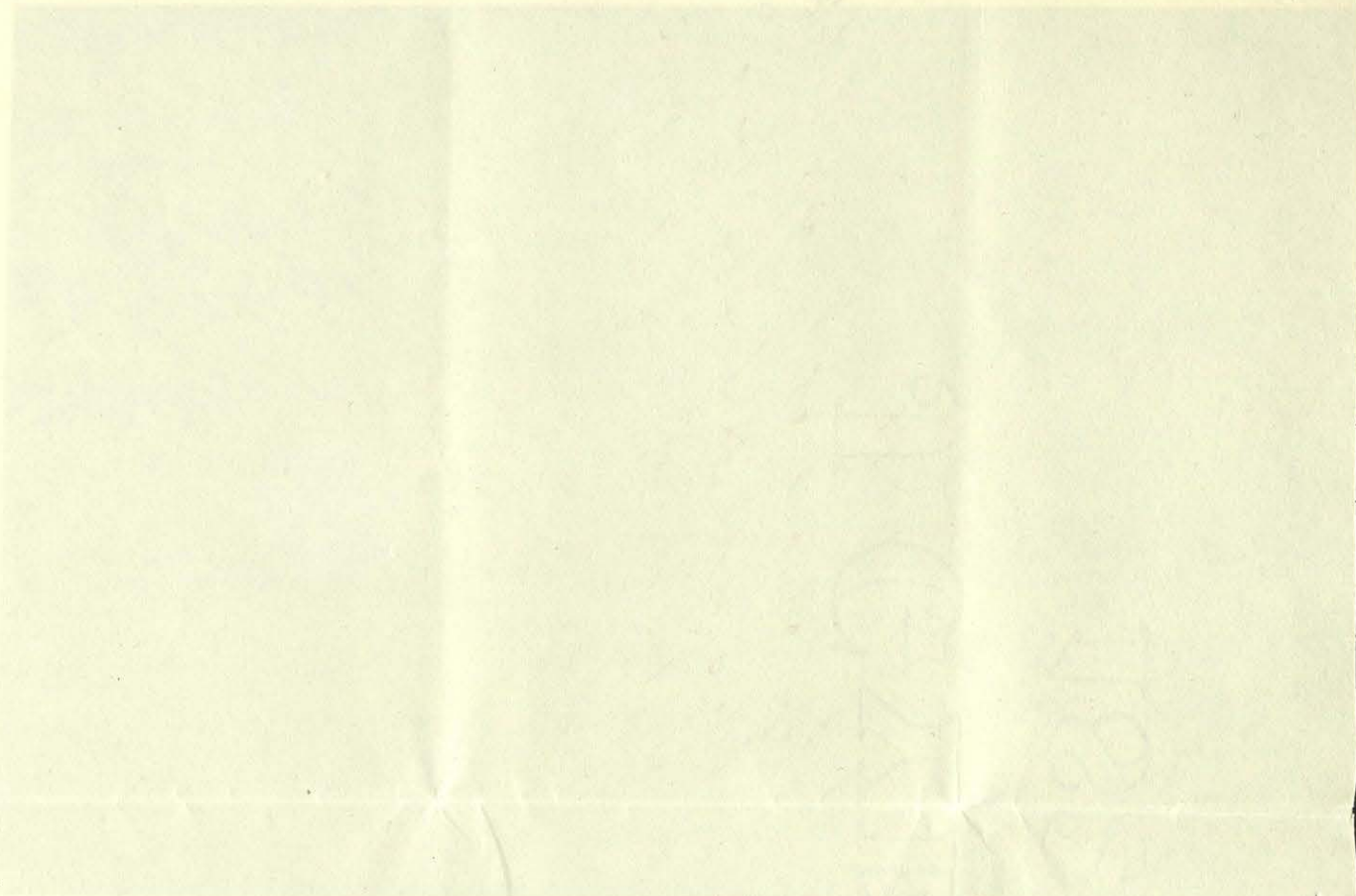
I thank you for your letter & present - The Picture
