I found on my return from your Majesty, that Monsieur Royneval was arriv'd at a Lodging in this neighbourhood, which my servant had indicated to him, when he was last here, to avoid the inconvenience which attended him before at

a very long conversation with him,  
the result of which has been, his  
sending a courier, to acquaint Monse-  
de Vergennes of the Impossibility  
of prevailing upon your Majesty,  
to think of ceding Gibraltar, without  
a complete restitution on the  
part of Spain, of every possession  
which she has taken, and the  
addition either of Porto Rico,  
or Martinique & S<sup>t</sup>. Lucie, or Gua-

and Dominique. I take it for granted that his admitting the two last to come into question is founded upon a prospect of prevailing with Spain to cede to them the whole of St. Domingo. On the other hand they would meet our wants of a Harbour as well as Wood and Water among the Leeward Islands. I venture to add that Your Majesty would expect the full value of all
