Jwas ordered by The Thing to wait on Your Troyal Highness to morrow to deliver a Message from His Majeshy, but finding your Proyal Highness is at Kindsot, Jam under the necessity of giving your Troyal Highness this trouble to acquaint you, by The Thing's Order, that His J. H. the Duke of flowerster having requested of His Majeshy to have his Marriage authenticated, as the Duthess of flowerster is near her Delivery, His Majeshy in founcil will give Orders, in consequence of that Application, that the Arch Bishop of London do forthwith Lord Chancellot, and the Bishop of London do forthwith enquire

enquire into the Legality of the said Martiage, and certify their Opinion, together with the Proofs to His Majesty in Council, in order that the same may be recorded in the Books of the Council Office. His Majesty will at the same time direct similar Steps to be immediately taken with regard to authenticating the Martiage of Your Royall Highness.
