Nov: 10. 1707

I am greatly flattered by your Goodness, in
sending Hunter down to Dover. I landed soon
after three this Evening, after a passage of 4 h. & 4
I have been waiting at Calais ever since Monday
last. The Laniages cannot be landed before Noon
tomorrow owing to the lowness of the tide. I shall
scarce I fear be in London before 12^{o'clock} at night.
I mean to go to Windsor early on Monday morning
I shall precede my family a couple hours, if it is
in my power to pay my respects to you Sir, either
at Carlton House, or Park Street I shall be rejoiced
to do it tomorrow night. and to assure you how
sincerely I am your humble servant,
