That Pensions and Annuities charged and to be paid out of such part of the Civil List Revenues as are hereditary in the Crown by Virtue of any Grants or Letters Patent of the Kings Prodecessors shall not be deemed or reckoned as part of the 700,000.  $\text{£ Ann.}$  for the Civil List.

Whether by Virtue of that Proviso the Civil List may not be eased of the following Pensions or Annuities which subsist by Grants of his Maj<sup>ty</sup> Prodecessors Viz<sup>t</sup>.
