

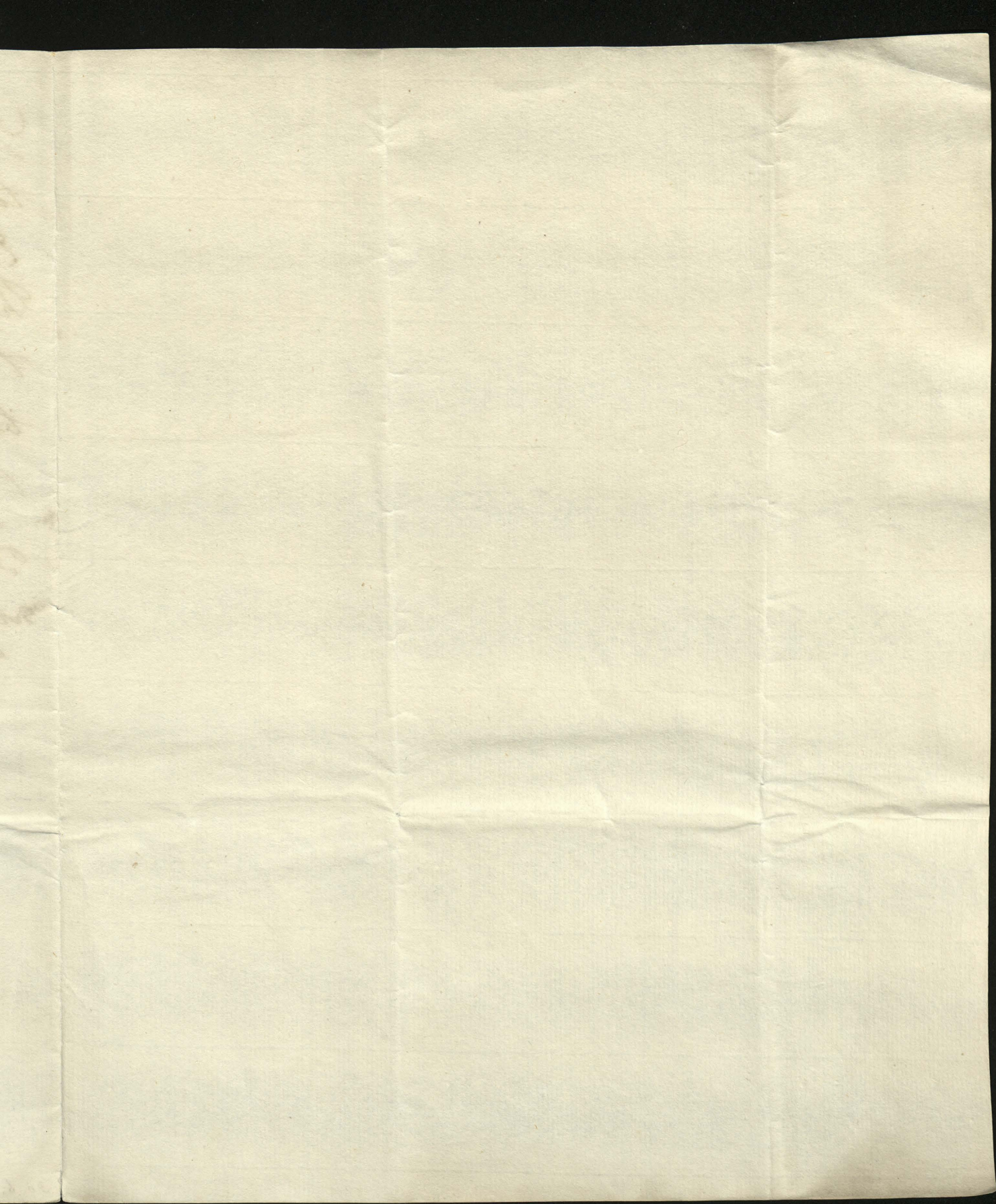

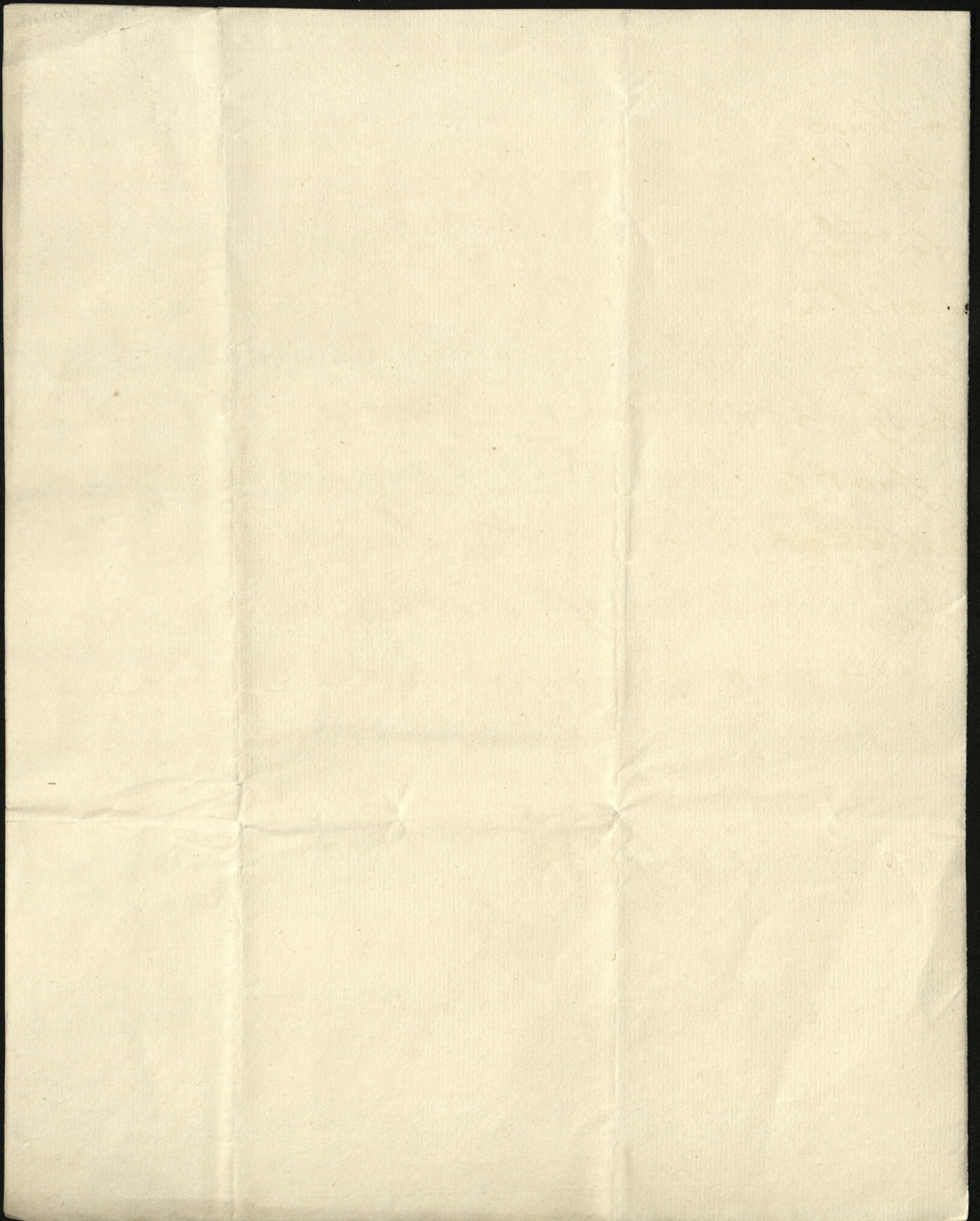
Mr Lee, I hope, You come to morrow to the House
