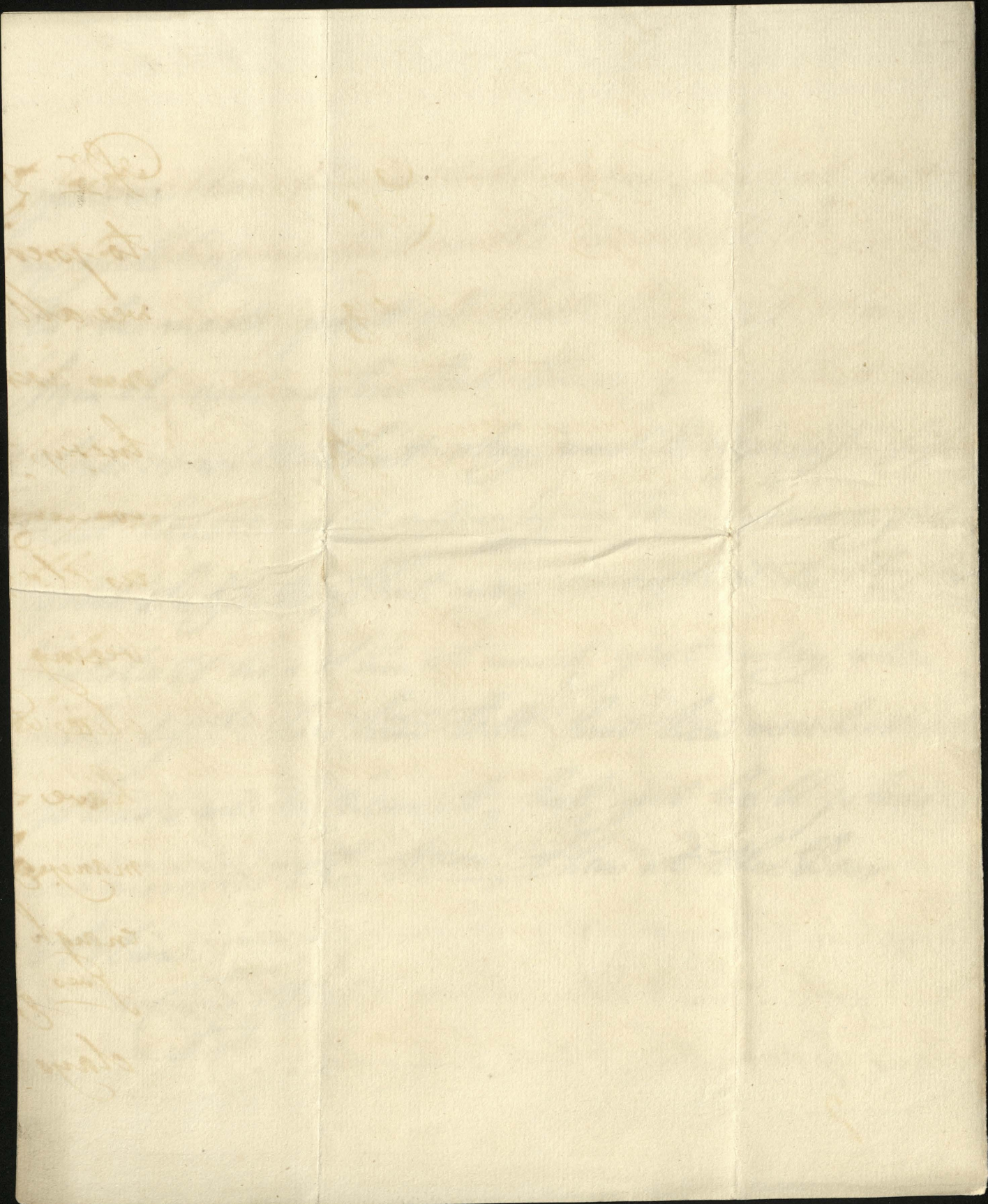
Dr Lee, I am sorry Y^r are not well enough
