The Beauclerc has laid down. Good night

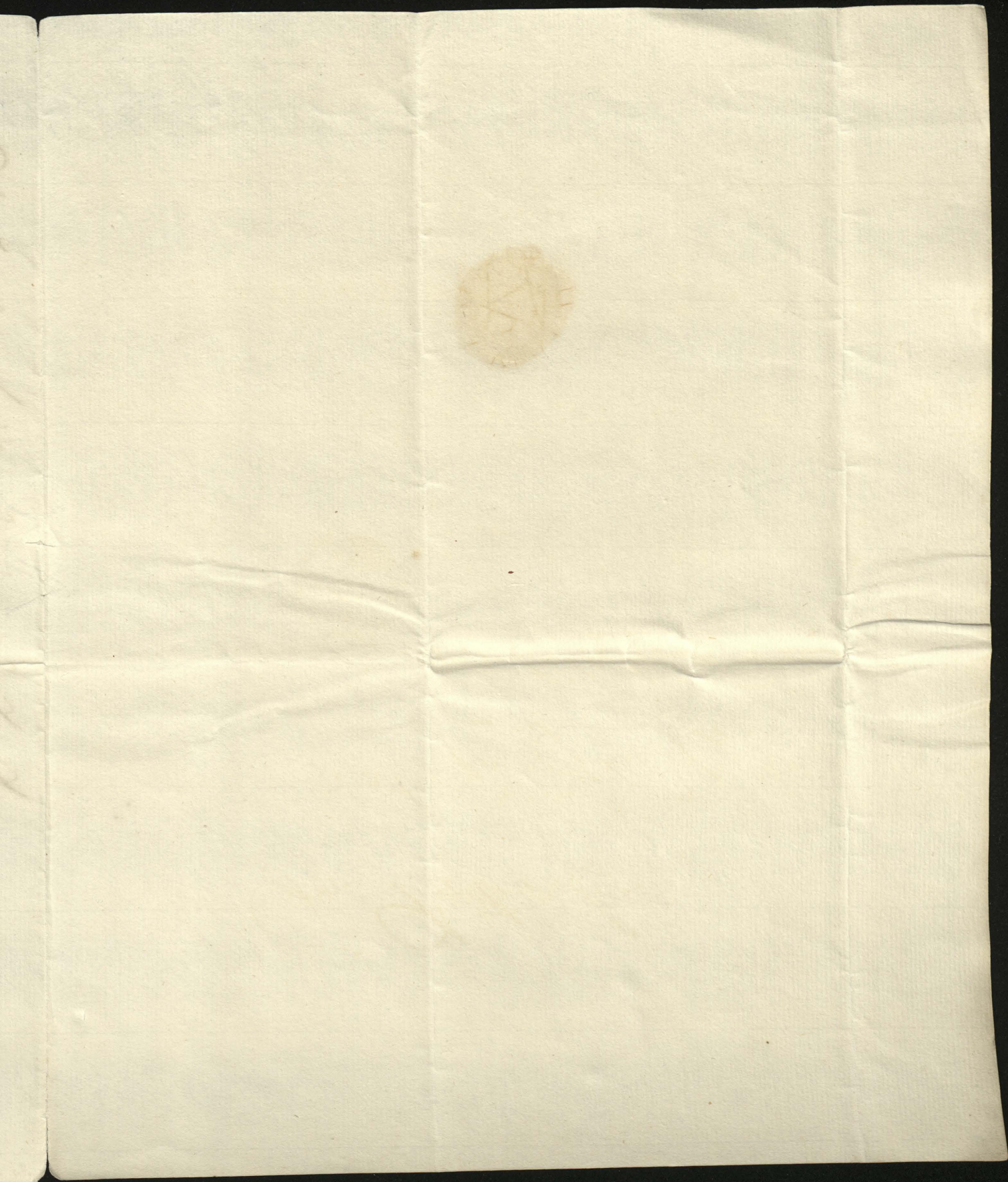

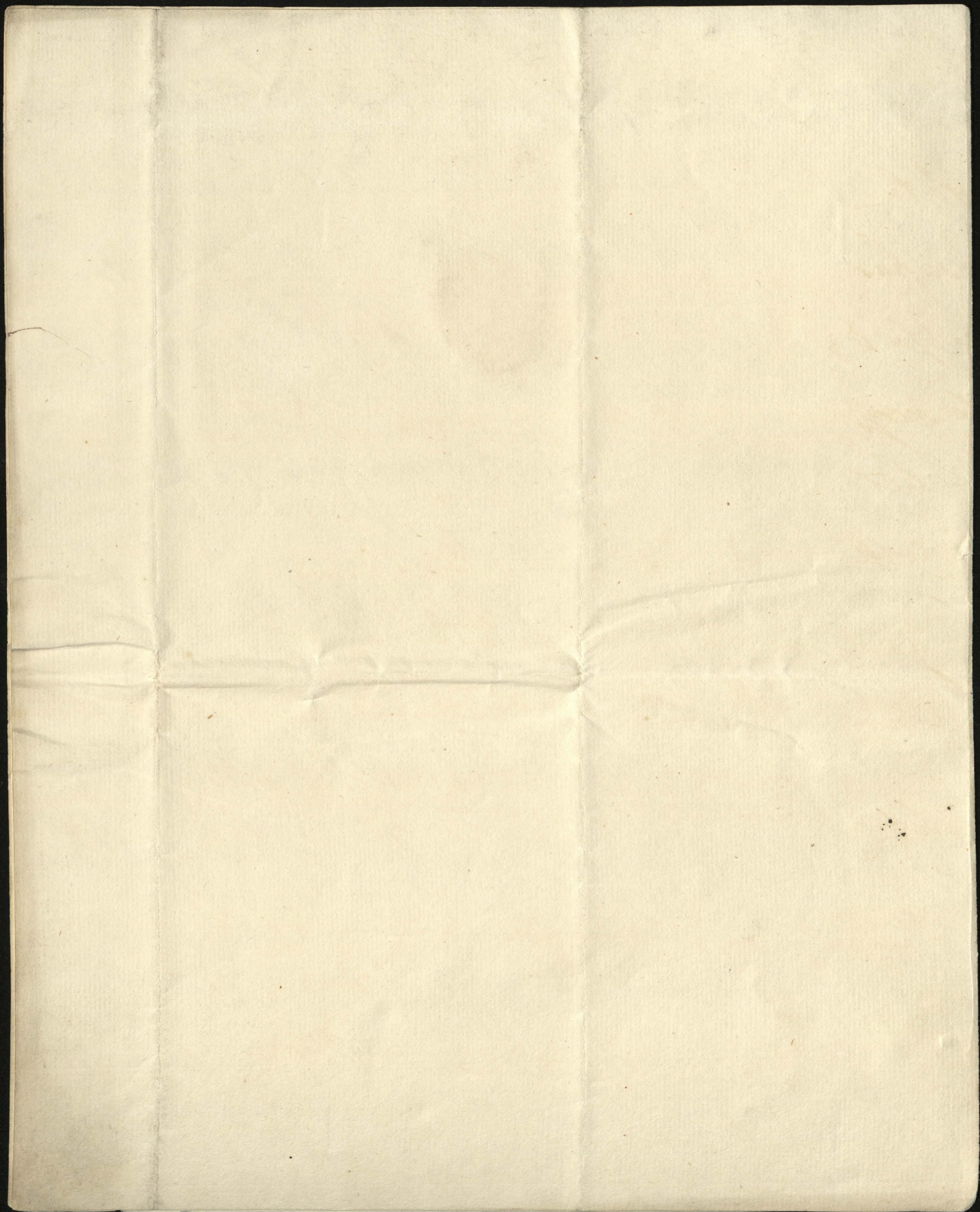
