Captain and Adjutant in Lieutenant
General Prags Regiment, Five years
Major of Marines, and Five years
Lieutenant Colonel, and now upon
half pay Pursuant to your Majesty's
Agreement with the Noblemen at the
late Rebellion. And that he always
attend'd his Duty.

He therefore most humbly
Prays your Majesty will be
most graciously pleas'd to
Grant him a Commission of
Lieutenant Colonel in any
of your Majesty's Regiments
