Kitchen to take them In.

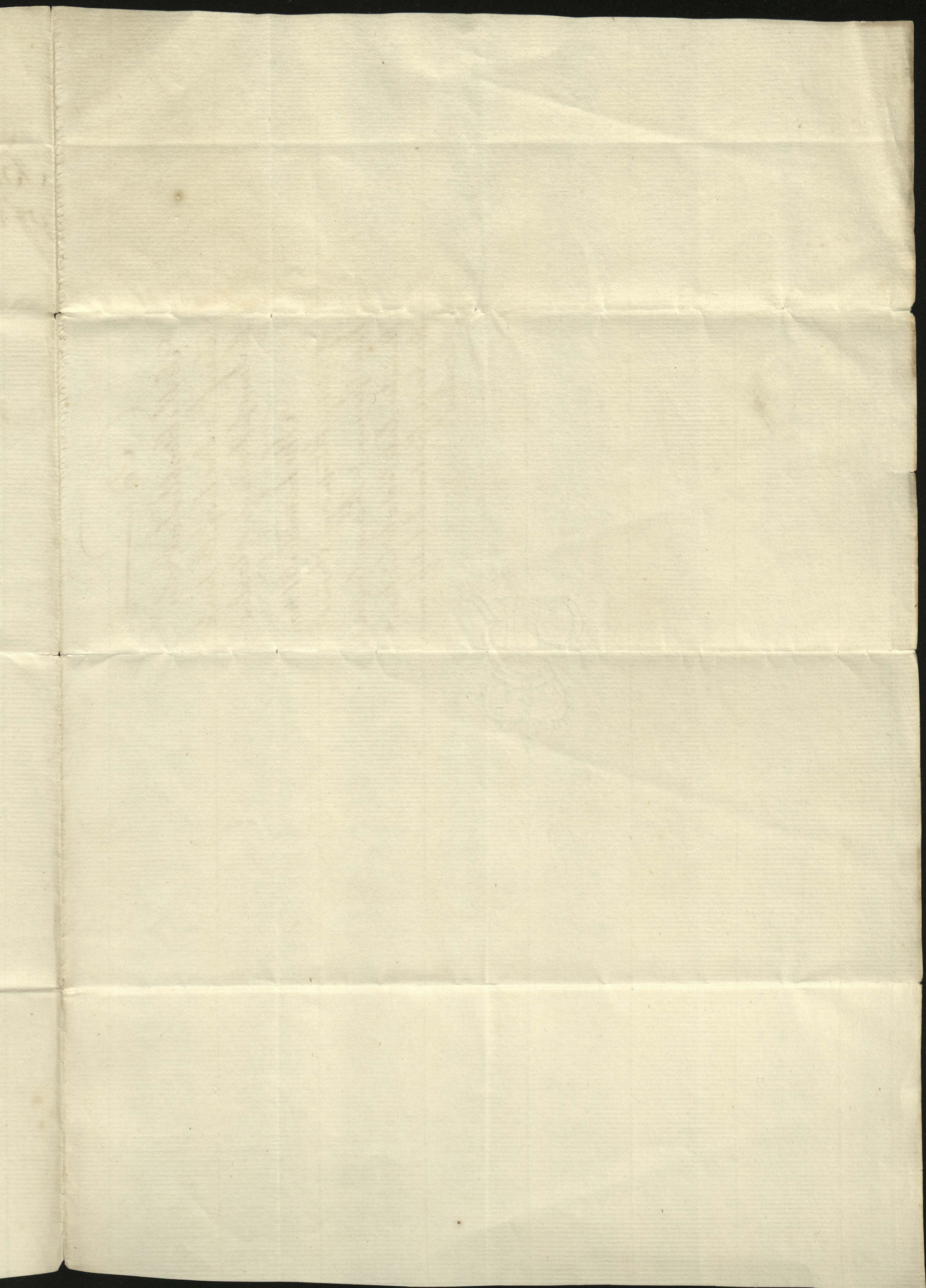
Your Petitioners therefore most humbly
