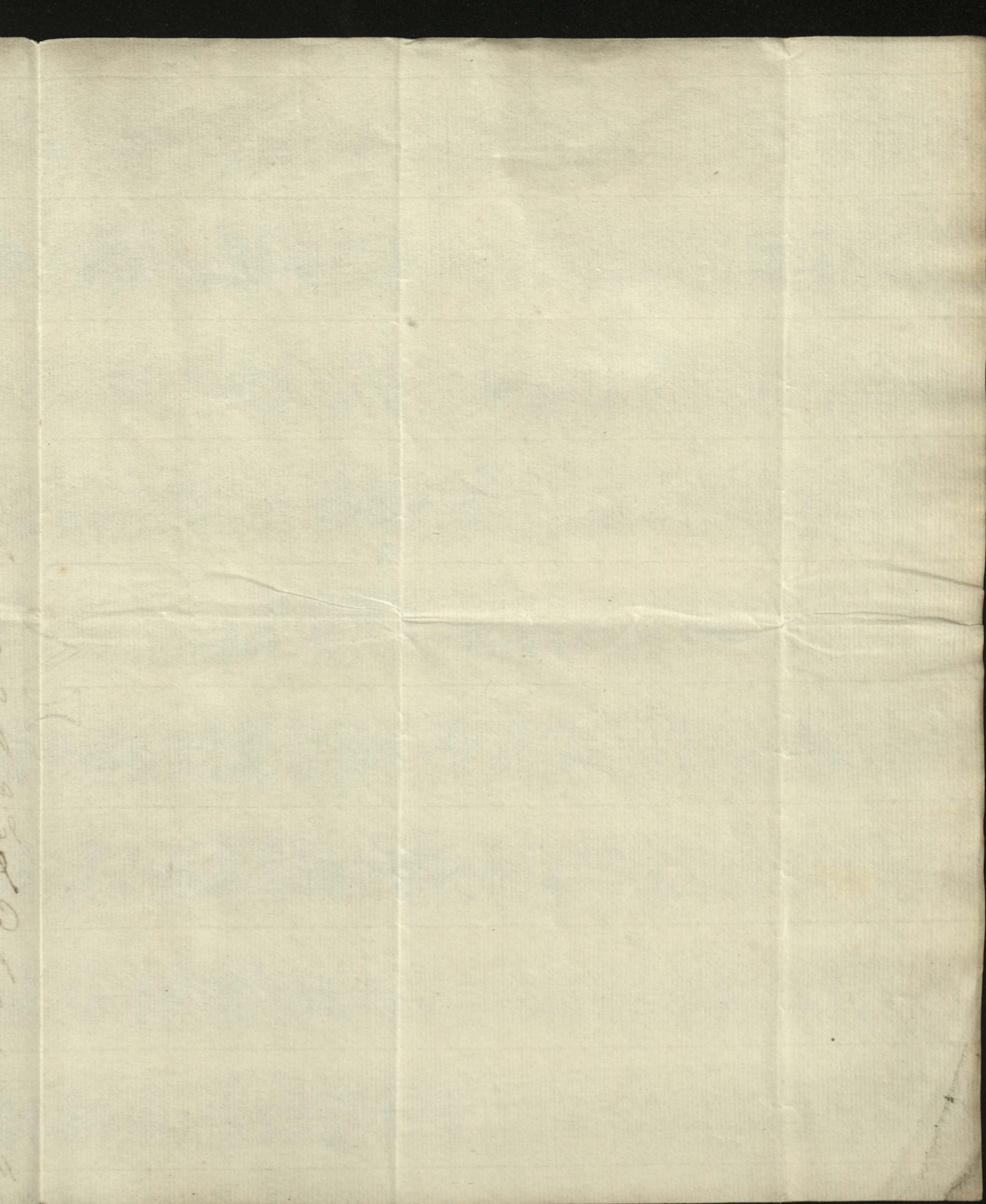
Sir

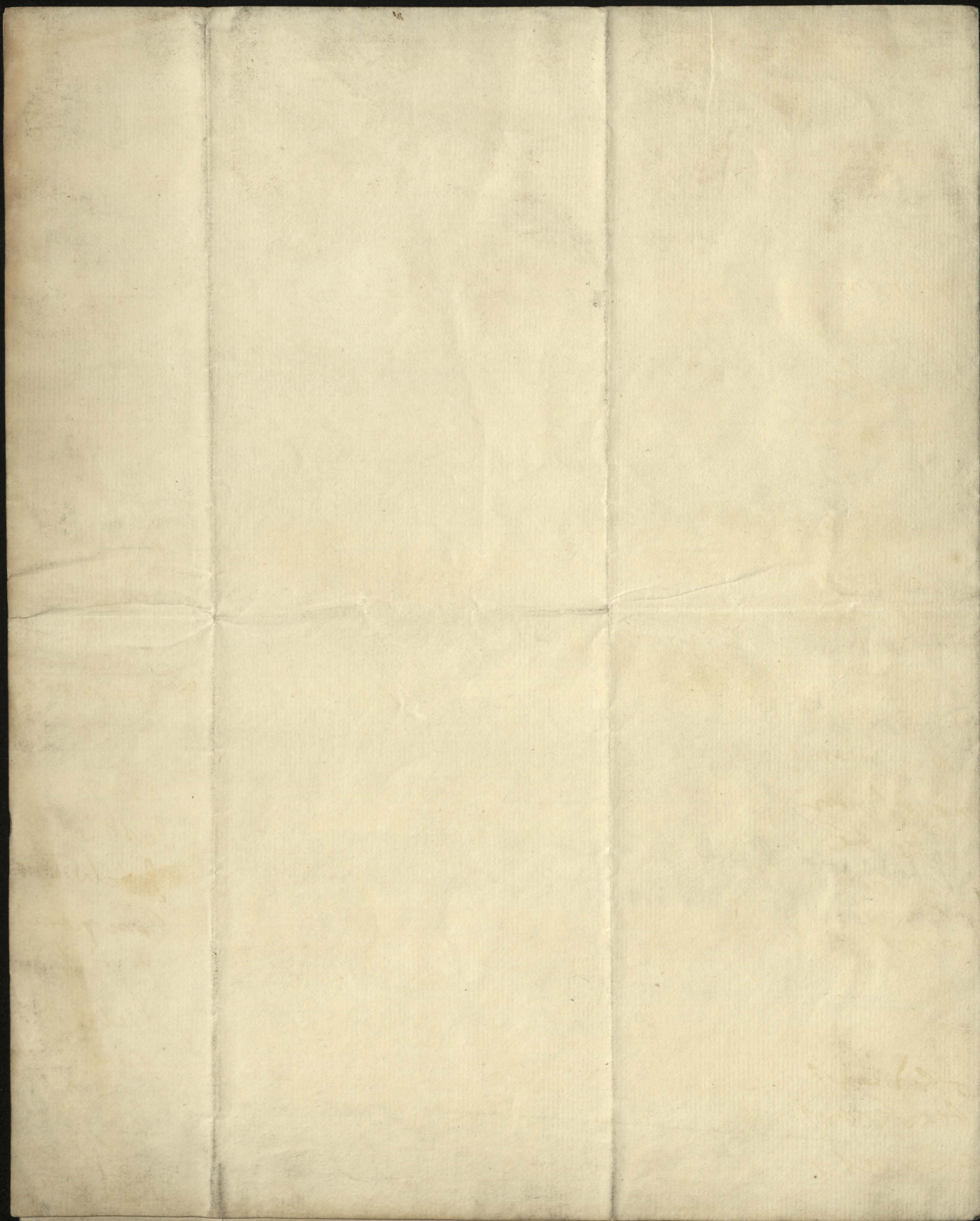
I am commanded by Her Royal Highness
