to a Clerk

Sir

I send my servant that I may be sure this reaches
 your hand. Her Royal Highness commands me to inform
 you that to morrow she will send the Compliments to
 Princess Amelia who acts a very handsome part, & inform
 the King that she shall always be glad to see thee when it
 suits the Conveynency.

I have been assured to day that the Question
 has been asked when you & I should be named, I informed
 Her Royal Highness of it. This is only for your self you
 will please to acquaint no Person whatever with this Circumstance
 till upon this to me doe shunt him the hand next Monday
 after which I will if you give one leave attend you to have
 the honor to kiss the Kings hand.

If you see the Duke of Newcastle as I hope you will to morrow,
 you may make him the Compliment to say that His
 Majesty desires his opinion, & lead him into the approbation of this
 measure insensibly if you can, for I think it a very right one for
 the reasons I offered to you yesterday, & others told me to day.
 Potter acts as I hear a most good part at Bath, Pray let me
 know at what hour to morrow I can see you, or wait upon
 you unless you chuse to write to me that I may show your
