utterly incapable of waiting on you in person

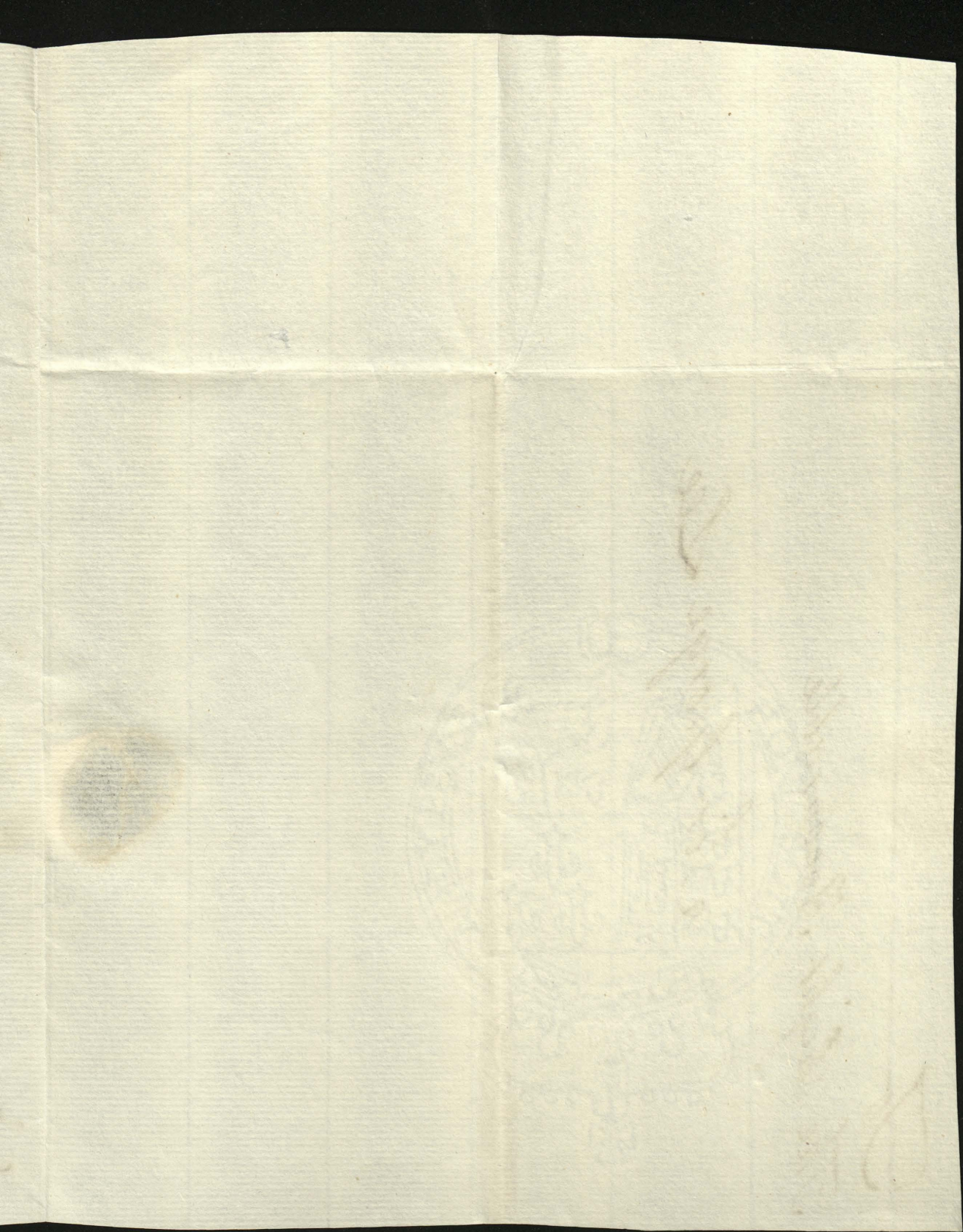
