I hope you will give orders as soon as possible, for frames to be made, according to Mr. Dillma's direction; for he can best tell, how large, & how many will be necessary for a proper supply of asparragus, & forward french beans. These frames will take but little room, & I believe, there will remain sufficient ground for all other things necessary for the service.

That you may not forget how the expence stands for the last three months, & also the price of the Dishes on an averidge, I have plac'd as beneath.
