The Duke of Grafton in obedience to his Majesty's
Commands, has the Honor to acquaint the King, that
the different Lords of the Cabinet were of Opinion that
before Monday Evening it would be dangerous to come
to any Resolutions, which, till then could not be duly
considered on so delicate a Situation. They agreed solely
to submit their Approbation of the intended temporary
Alteration of the Garrison of Gibraltar as necessary
for his Majesty's Service, meaning also to meet
on Thursday next on the Affairs of Canada.
