Lord Hertford presumes to inform  
his Majesty that as having been  
able to prevail upon other  
Duchesses or Marchionesses to attend  
the funeral since the Duchess  
of Grafton has declined it, he  
hopes his Majesty will approve his  
having taken the only method he  
could of supplying the vacancy in  
the widow's wifery, by engaging  
Lady Harrington to be one of the  
assistants in the place of the highest  
of the Baudys who with his Majesty's  
approbation will become one of the  
supporters to the chief mourner which  
honor will now forsake Baudy if his  
Majesty has no objection to devolve upon  
the Duchess of Manchester; Lord Hertford

has done every thing in his power to contribute to the stability & integrity of the currency & is much concerned to have such frequent occasion to trouble his majesty upon the difficulties which have occurred.

Sir Hertford had the honor of acquainting his majesty that he has received a letter from Mr Charles Cottrell desiring him to inform his majesty that the Prince of Monaco will acknowledge it as a particular favor if his majesty will permit him to take leave of his majesty on wednesday next as he is obliged to return to Paris
