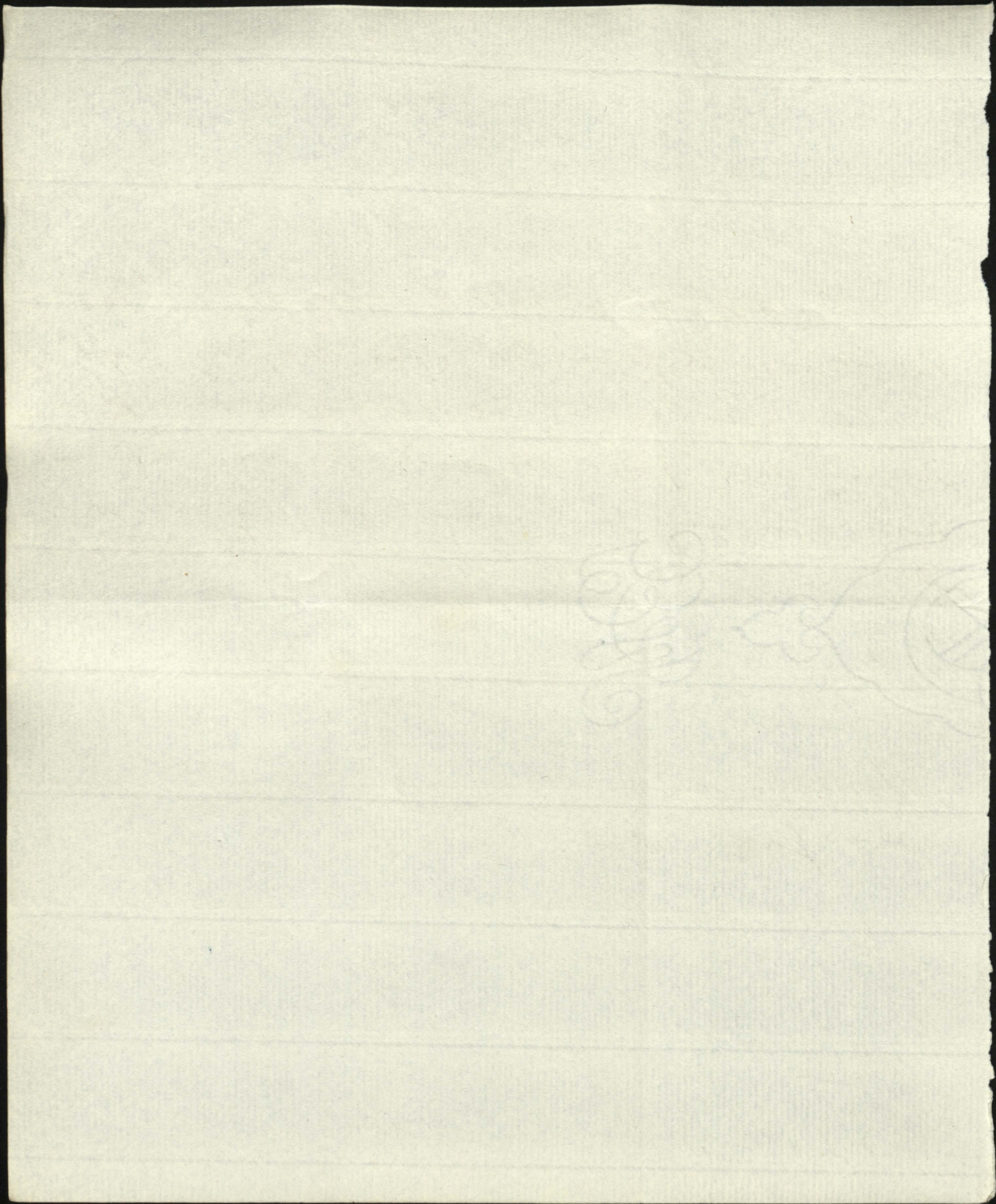


Sir David Dundas has the honor to inform His
