I will not fail to tell Mrs. all your kind expressions and the words and questions expressed about her health - He has been perfectly quiet all day and my Mother, Fulkner and Williams both desired me to tell her they would not ask to see her till she should be there - I shall be most happy to dine with you tomorrow and trust that we may be more easy about the General, but there sudden change though both Physicians have proposed care for them I am almost very considerably
