My dear Papa

I am most happy in being able to say dear Sophia has continued very much better all day was able to dine with us & assured me she felt very comfortable this evening —

As to dear Amelia this has not been quite so good a day as yesterday as the cold weather affects her very much & not withstanding all the care that is taken it is difficult to prevent her getting more cold her head has been much stuffed to day partly from a fresh cold & partly from a slight degree of Coryza that has come out about the throat & eyes which has caused more headach this evening

however Dr Pope did not allow Amelia  
and at all more only not so well  
as yesterday, but has not found it  
necessary to alter any thing —  
I shall add to her morning  
she was passed the night —
