

Dec. 1 [1812]

My dear Mr. Butler I arrived at
two o'clock & went immediately
into the Queen when we had as
much as I expected spent
improvements as to business & look
not did but never the sub long
coming & consequence - he must

happened at your Queen last night
&c. She asked no questions
concerning the House of Lords
& particularly said she had
not read the speech or did
she wish to know anything
that I had - so of course I had

the same she take years
days at us all mind

long to provoke us but that
of course we cannot be quite
above - From the account
Augusta & Felix give she
was nearly the same with
them all yesterday -

she did this morning
but still looks very weary
