My Dearest Mary,

The kind letter which I received from you this morning appears to me to convey upon the whole a less unsatisfactory Account of the State of dear America, and I had also been in some degree relieved by the General Observations & References given to me by Doctor Cooper when here on Thursday last; but I have still to lament that the slow Progress which she makes is subject to such Interruptions and to the absolute necessity of resorting to Remedies which, in their momentary Effect, are so distressing, and must so greatly increase the Pain & Sufferings to which she is subjected with so much fortitude & Resignation
