thanking you for your very kind letter of yesterday - your
Report of dear Amelia is more satisfactory than I could have
expected under the Impression which must have been made
upon her by the shocking accident which has happened.
I stay poor Sir Harry Burrard from my heart, and can
easily conceive what Sir Harry & Lady Anne must feel upon this
truly melancholy event. I how sympathize it must have been
to you all. — I saw Doctor Pope yesterday; he entered very
fully into dear Amelia's situation & I trust that what
he said will be satisfactory to her.
