My dearest Papa
Again I have to express my
most grateful thanks for another kind
kind letter received by the Post yesterday
I am sorry to say Amelia passed a very
unpleasant day from pain in the side
some degree of fever & languor very
distressing to herself she went into the
warm bath which always agrees
with her & enjoys a quiet night
after which she certainly had
and some sleep, but is unwell
this morning complains of feeling
very uncomfortable & much distressed
Bears who has just been with
her says it is in consequence of
the medicine she takes as reported
this morning & that unless she
has been out in the morning
she flatters herself she will feel

letter Amelia desires me to say
she shall write if possible by to
morrow but had from learning
her so unwell here last three
days we persuaded her not to
write so sometimes the writing
brings on pain in the side -
