 & she was very faint

 at times but she

 strong letter than  
 she expected to  
 write & so for so  
 very I must off better

 we got to Glaston which  
 I had no idea of where  
 I left Plymouth - She  
 went to bed soon after  
 10 o'clock & has had  
 more sleep than  
 was expected though  
 much pain at times  
 in the night &  
 much fatigued but  
 Dr. P's says we are  
 to leave this at  
 11 o'clock as the Pulse  
 is very tolerable  
 my heart was a full

when I started from  
 you yesterday I could  
 not expect all I should  
 to say & how much  
 I feel your kindness in  
 writing to me as  
 far to Providence  
 I hope you found  
 well
